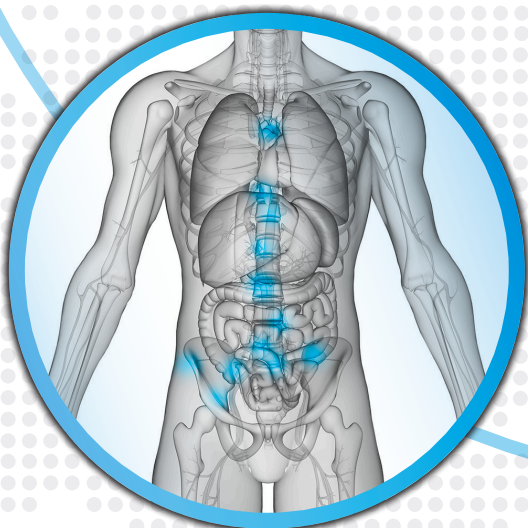

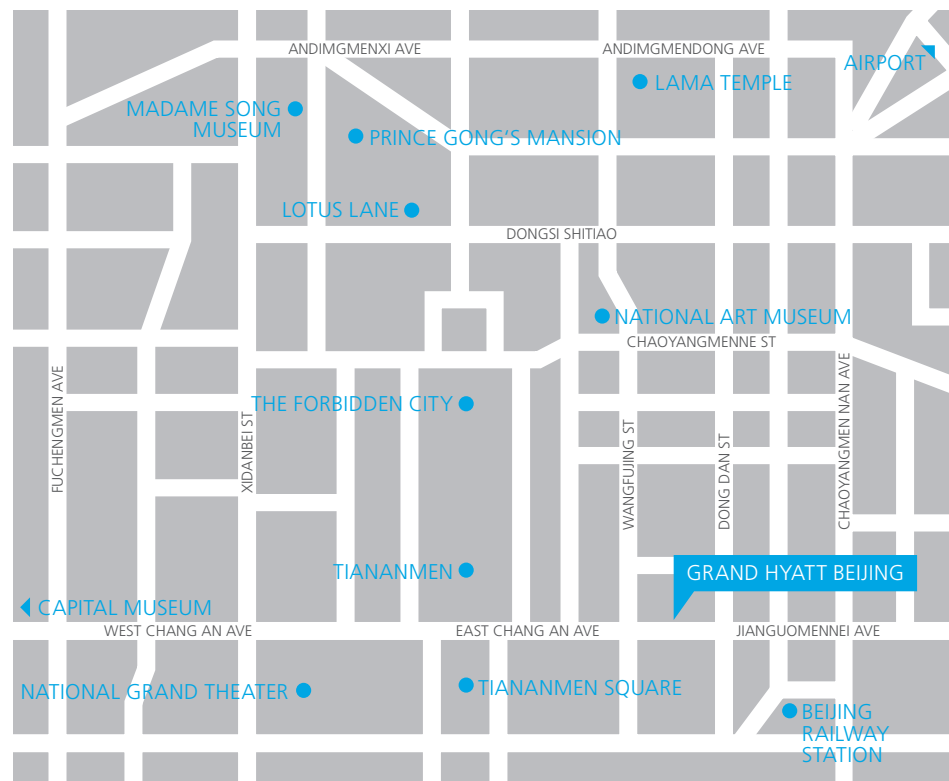
Welcome cocktail reception at the Grand Hyatt Beijing.
